INTERNATIONAL LAW QUIZ COMPETITION

Rules for Law Quiz

- Each Team shall comprise of three participants.
- There shall be only one team from one college.
- The preliminary round shall be in the written form.
- The questions shall be in the form of multiple choice, true /false statements, specific answer based etc.
- Team scoring the highest marks in the written quiz shall qualify for the final round.
- Quiz will cover topics related to:
 - Alternative Dispute Resolution
 - Leading Case Laws of Alternative Dispute Resolution
- The quiz shall be conducted within a span of 2 hours.

Sequence

- Screening Round (written)
- There are 50 Multiple Choice Questions in the Preliminary written round.
- Time duration for Preliminary round is 1 hour.
- On the basis of merit, teams shall qualify for the final round.
- After the Preliminary round, test copies will be checked and the result for the teams selected for the final round will be declared.
- Law Quiz (Duration 2 Hours)

Law Quiz Rounds-(Duration-30min.perround.)

Round-I

- 5 questions shall be put up per team.
- 30 seconds shall be given for giving the answer.
- 10 marks each shall be awarded for the correct answer and 5 marks shall be awarded for the bonus question.
- The question shall pass only once to the next team.

Round-II (30 Min)-Case Law Round

- Rules similar or round-I
- Case laws related to Constitutional Law.

Round III. Audio Visual Round (BuzzerRound-15 Clippings)

- The teams shall view the screen for the visual question or listen to the audio clipping and then provide the answer.
- The respondent, who presses the buzzer the earliest, shall answer the question.
- Other rules are similar to round I.

Round IV. Rapid Fire Round

- Questions shall be put up before the teams within a span of **one** minute.
- Questions will be based on a particular law from the previously mentioned list on the basis
 of draw of lots.
- The question shall not pass to the next team.
- The respondent has to provide the answers in quick succession.
- Each Question shall be of 10 marks each.

Round V. Questions for Audience

• The questions will be put upon a random basis to the audience at any time after the Commencement of the Quiz. The candidate, who provide stheright answer, shall be awarded on the spot.
