**Rules for five year Law Course
(Semester System)**


1. The Degree of Bachelor of law B.A.LL.B. Shall comprise a course of study spread over a period of five academic years and candidate will have to be a full time student. All the colleges shall be full time day colleges.
2. Candidate seeking admission to the B.A.LL.B. degree must have passed an examination in 10+2 course of schooling recognized by the educational authority of Central of state government with securing minimum 50% marks in aggregate.
3. Age for admission in B.A.LL.B. degree, is maximum 20 years in case of general category applicants and 22 years in the case of S.C. / S.T. and O.B.C.
4. Candidate for the B.A.LL.B. five years degree course shall be required to pass ten semester examinations, which shall be held in the month of December and May of each academic year.
5. Student shall be required to put in a minimum attendance of 75% of the lectures on each of the subject as also at tutorial.

Provided that in exceptional cases for reasons to be recorded the Dean of the Faculty of Law and Principal of Law Colleges may condone attendance short of those candidates who had attended 60% of the lectures in the aggregate.

6. Rules for promotion to the next semester and higher class of FYDC :-
 - (i) From odd semester to even semester :
A candidate shall who has appeared in the odd semester (Theory and practical) examination in any particular year shall be promoted to an even semester of the year, irrespectively of failing in any number of theory paper and practical examination of that semester.
 - (ii) From even semester to odd semester :
A candidate who has appeared in the even semester (Theory and practical) examination in any particular year shall not be promoted to next semester and higher class, if he carries a backing of more then two papers.
7. The minimum passing marks of each paper (Theory and practical) shall be 40 marks and passing mark in aggregate(Theory and practical) shall be 50% of that
8. A candidate shall not be permitted to appear/re appear in any examination or any paper in which he has been declared pass by the University for any purpose whatever.

9. Ex-studentship :-
Subject to the general rule of promotion a candidate shall become ex-student irrespectively of failing in any number of theory paper and practical examination of that year.
10. Revaluation of answer books shall be allowed as per provisions of Ordinance 6.
11. The subjects and papers for each year of B.A.LL.B. shall be prescribed by the faculty of Law on the recommendation of the board of studies. Unless otherwise provided each paper will carry the written exam of 80 marks and internal assessment of 20 marks. The candidate will have to pass separately in written papers and practical.
12. The minimum pass marks in each year examination shall be 50% in aggregate of all the papers and 40% marks in each individual paper. Division to successful candidate for the B.A.LL.B. degree will be assigned of total marks obtained by him at the B.A.LL.B. First year, Second year, Third year, Fourth year and Final year examinations i.s. all ten semester as under.

FIRST DIVISION : 60% or above of the aggregate marks.

SECOND DIVISION : 50% or above of the aggregate marks.

- Note :-** (i) No third division shall be awarded.
(ii) Candidate who obtained 75% or more marks in aggregate shall be declared to have passed the B.A.LL.B. degree course in First division with distinction.

13. For each paper there shall be lecture classes for at least 6 hours per week.
14. Candidate appearing for B.A.LL.B. examination shall have to answer the question in English or Hindi Medium.
15. The rules are subject to change in accordance with the directives of Bar Council of India and instructions issued by Department of Higher. Education, Govt. of M.P. from time to time and adopted and notified by the University.

- Note :-** (i) These rules are subject to alteration from time to time.
(ii) These rules are subject to provisions of the Act, Statutes and Ordinance as in force from time to time.

Five years Course

226

This ordinance shall be applicable in University teaching department as well as affiliated Colleges.

1. The Degree of Bachelor of Law (BBA, LL.B. (Hons) & B.Com. LL.B. (Hons) Shall comprise of a course of study spread over a period of five years and the candidates will be full time regular students. The five year course shall comprise two parts i.e. part - I, which will be a two year core programme of pre-law study and part-II which will be a three Year programme for professional training in law.
2. THE ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS;
 - (a) At the time of joining the course of instruction in law, the person concerned has to pass an examination in 10+2 course of schooling recognized by the educational authority of Central or State Government or posses academic qualification considered equivalent to 10+2 courses by the Bar Council of India.
 - (b) Lateral entry will be permitted in Third Year of the course to graduates of any discipline as prescribed by Bar Council of India after the entrance test depending on the availability of seats.
 - (c) The candidate must have completed the age of 17 Years at the time of admission. Maximum age for admission shall not be more than 22 years. (age of admission shall be subjected to approval of the concerned board of studies as per guidelines of B.C.I. in this regards.
3. The admission to the course shall be through an entrance examination/merit.
4. Details of subjects to be taught during the five years courses, curriculum pattern and examination scheme for each year course shall be subject to approval of the concerned Board of studies/Faculty as per the guidance of the Bar Council of India in this regard.



GENERAL RULES FOR THREE YEARS' LAW COURSE
(SEMESTER SYSTEM)**

1. The LL. B. (Hons.) course shall be a three year degree course (T.Y.D.C.) namely. LL B. (Hons.) First Year (I & II Semester), LL B (Hons.) Second Year (III & IV Semester) and LL. B. (Hons.) Final Year (V & VI Semester) and shall be of three year duration. All the teaching time-span in colleges shall be full time (day) colleges.
2. Candidates seeking admission to the LL. B. (Hons.) degree course must have passed degree examination from any recognized University and must have secured minimum 45% of marks for general category and 40% in case of S.C/S.T. applicants.
3. Candidates for the LL. B. (Hons.) Three Year Degree Course shall be required to pass six semester examinations which shall be held in the month of December and May of each academic year.
4. Students shall be required to put in a minimum 75% attendance of the lectures in each of the subjects as also at tutorials, moot courts and practical training course.
Provided that in exceptional cases for reasons to be recorded and communicated to the Bar Council of India the Dean of the Faculty of Law and the Principal of Law Colleges may condone attendance short of those required by the Rule, if the student had attended 70% of the lectures in the aggregate for the semester.
5. A Candidate who, after taking the Bachelor's degree of this University or of any other University recognized for this purpose, has completed a regular course of study of law in a constituent or an affiliated College of this University for an academic semester, shall be eligible for appearing in the aforesaid examination.

6. Rules for. promotion to the next semester and higher class of 3YDC:

(i) From. odd semester to even semester:

(iii) The minimum passing marks in each, paper (Theory & practical) shall be 40 marks and passing marks in aggregate (Theory/Practical) shall be 50 percent of that Semester Examination.

(iv) A candidate shall be allowed to carry a particular semester if he has acquired minimum passing marks in all the papers (Theory/Practical) of that semester and has failed in aggregate by reason thereof, such a candidate shall be allowed to reappear in semester examination in any number of papers of his choice in which he has acquired minimum passing marks in that semester in order to pass in aggregate in such semester examination but shall not be allowed to reappear in any paper (Theory/Practical) in which he has already acquired passing marks, that is 50% or more marks.



This paper may have three components of 30 marks each and a viva for 10 marks.
