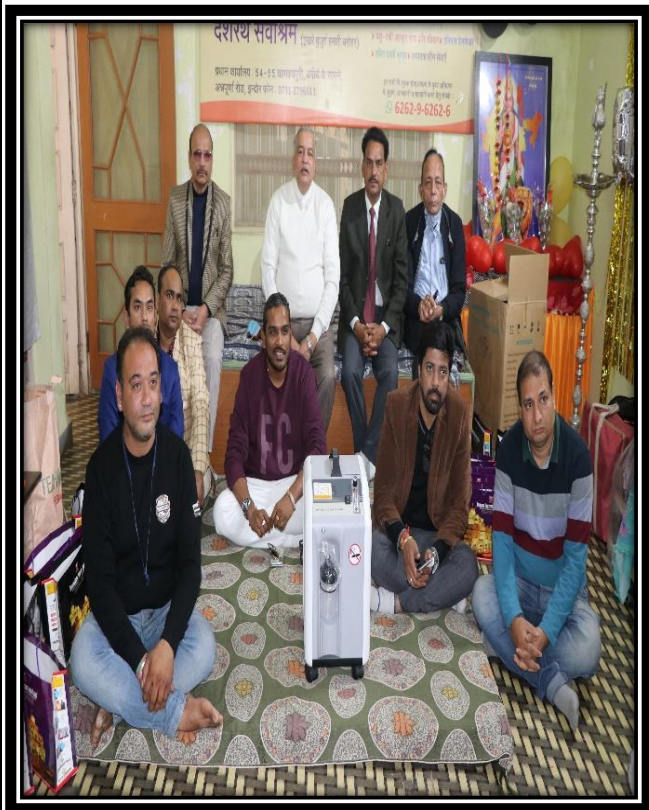

## Workshop at Labour Commission “Rights of Workers at workplace”

On the 27th of May 2023, a workshop was conducted at the Labour Legal Aid Clinic, under the auspices of the Assistant Labour Commission. The workshop was attended by 44 students. The workshop aimed to educate students about workers' rights in the workplace, with a focus on the Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Maan-dhan (PM-SYM) scheme. Organized by the Carrier Development Cell and Skill Development Cell, the workshop served as an informative session to empower workers with knowledge about their entitlements and benefits.

The workshop began with the organizers highlighting the significance of understanding and exercising one's rights as a worker. This is a comprehensive overview of the legal framework governing workers' rights in India, emphasizing key legislation such as the Minimum Wages Act, Employee Provident Fund (EPF) Act, and Industrial Disputes Act.

Detailed information was provided about the Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Maan-dhan (PM-SYM) scheme, which aims to provide pension benefits to unorganized sector workers. The eligibility criteria, benefits, and enrollment process were elucidated to ensure participants' understanding and encourage uptake.

The importance of workplace safety and health regulations was emphasized, highlighting employers' responsibility to provide a safe working environment and measures for redressal in case of violations. Students were educated about the fundamental rights of workers, including the right to fair wages, safe working conditions, and the right to form trade unions for collective bargaining. The lively question and answer session provided students with an opportunity to seek clarification on specific queries and share their experiences related to workplace rights and grievances.

The workshop concluded with a closing remark that emphasized the empowerment of workers through knowledge and awareness of their rights. Workers expressed their appreciation for the insightful session and pledged to disseminate the information they had acquired to their peers and colleagues. The event served as a significant step towards promoting a culture of awareness and advocacy for workers' rights within the community.

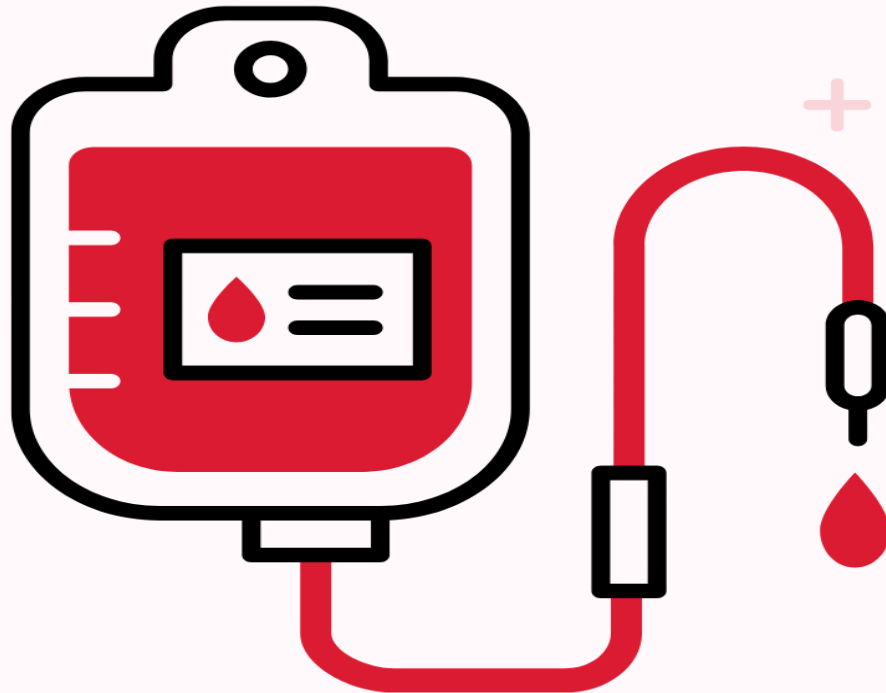
