THE DECENTRALIZATION & ACTIVE PARTICIPATION OF MANAGEMENT

(6.1.2)

Strong & Effective leadership is not about doing everything the best yourself; it is about bringing together a team and leading everyone to perform to the best of their abilities. The success of any institution and its management is indisputably reflected by the participation & contribution of its staff. The success of an institution is best reflected by the efficacy of its grass root level – An equally effective performance from the top management to the grass root staff is the true reflection of successful leadership & decentralization.

The Governing Body of Indore Institute of Law puts accentuation on collaborative efforts in the development of the institution and staunchly gives credence to **Decentralization and Participative Management** in its administrative body for all circumscribing growth of the Institute.

Decentralization, Democracy and Participative Management in the institute can be seen from its constitutional structure. The structure holds together a covenant of 45 institutional bodies which comprises of 6 student/faculty societies and 6 clubs. The remaining are various cells and committees constituted by students, teachers, management and alumni of the institution – all working together for the cohesive development of the institution as a whole.

This case study is based on the International Law Fest “Lex Bonanza” – a first of its kind celebration of law that was conceptualised by Indore Institute of Law in the year 2012 and has maintained its legacy of successive advancement over the last 10 years. It is a perfect example of systematic decentralization of responsibilities over months of strategy development, preparation and execution. The Institution as a whole comes together to achieve its mission of evolving and imparting legal education with the aim of excellence, promotion of democratic values and the principles of inclusiveness, cultural inculcation & ethical values to further the principle of Rule of Law with the end goal of economic & social justice.

The **first chapter** of Lex Bonanza was introduced in the year **2012**. Till date the institute has organized 11 chapters of the fest. Each chapter grander than the last with academic innovations, better opportunities, greater participation and grander execution.

ABOUT LEX BONANZA

The International Law Fest “Lex-Bonanza”, is a first of its kind celebration of law conceptualised by Indore Institute of Law and has building its legacy of successive advancement over the last 11 years. An event aimed at conducting a series of legal competitions like moot court competition, parliamentary debate, mediation-negotiation competition, research paper presentation etc. The Institution comes together to achieve its mission of imparting legal education with the aim of excellence, promotion of democratic values and the principles of inclusiveness, cultural inculcation & ethical values building **Just, Competent & Globally Sensitized Legal Professional**.

Lex Bonanza is a 3-day event in which several legal competitions are conducted. Hundreds of students participate in it from across the world. Numerous veteran legal professional adorns the campus of Indore Institute of Law for judging the Competitions and share their expertise with students of law.

INTERNATIONAL LAW FEST “LEX BONANZA” – AN ANALYTICAL STUDY

PRE-PLANNING

SKILL DEVELOPMENT CELL

At the beginning of the session, Skill Development Cell calls a meeting of the student council, society & club representatives and student representatives in college. On the basis of input received, the SDC then strategizes upon the competitions to be conducted and distributes responsibility of each competition to respective clubs & societies. The content for the competition strategy is prepared and the president of the student council is made responsible for preparation of estimated budget. The report of events to be conducted and budget required is prepared in consultation and forwarded to the Principal. The Principal in consultation with the staff finalizes the proposal and forwards it to the IQAC. The IQAC assess the budget and approves the same with due knowledge of the Governing Body. The principal then allocates duty to staff members & SDC starts working collaboratively with students for registrations, invitations, brochures in coordination with all stakeholders.

PREPARATORY WORKING

PRINCIPAL, DEAN, ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE, INTERNAL FINANCE & AUDIT COMMITTEE

The Alumni, CDC & Parents start working on guests & judges coordination. The Dean with Management intimates and gives instructions to Internal Administrative Committee & Internal Finance & Audit Committee working on infrastructural requirements and arrangements. Making arrangements for travel, accommodation, meals, banners, flexes, mementos, awards all are coordinated by the administrative committee in coordination with Finance Committee. The Faculties in coordination with student committees make arrangements for competitions like preparation of moot proposition, debate notions, conference theme, quizzes etc. Conduction is managed by the Faculties & Arrangements are made by the Administrative & Finance Committee.

EXECUTIONARY WORKING

IQAC, TEACHING STAFF, NON-TEACHING STAFF, STUDENT COMMITTEES & CLUBS, PRINCIPAL & DEAN

The Teaching Staff & Non Teaching Staff are at the forefront of conducting the activities and are supported by the Skill Development Cell, Student Council & Volunteers in successful execution. The Administrative Committee supports with regards to hospitality of guests, participants & judges. The student committee is significantly functional in maintaining protocols and adherence to college rules & decorum. The Teaching & Non-Teaching Staff work in coordination for managing the academic front and the functionality of competitions being conducted as part of the event to ensure impartiality and just execution. The management contributes in the Inaugural & Valedictorian ceremonies conducted for the event and are functional in hospitality for the guests & luminaries. Industry Experts & Alumni contribute significantly as judges and guests for the activities being conducted.

POST CONDUCTION WORKING

ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE & SKILL DEVELOPMENT CELL WITH STUDENT BODIES

Disbursement of prize money, mementos & awards. Publication of results and event proceedings on social media platforms and news media outlets. Bills settlement for arrangements like conveyance, accomodation, food. Event Report files is maintained by the SDC.

1. The strategy planning for the academic activities start 3 months prior to the tentative date of Lex Bonanza as per the academic calendar.
2. The **Skill Development Cell** calls an annual meeting of all the student bodies i.e., student councils, societies and clubs in order to discuss the organization of event, allocation of student/faculty duties and to make a tentative budget for the international event.
3. These duties are allocated by the faculty co-ordinators of the Skill Development Cell and the list of pre-requisites and various other requirements are asked from them and the arrangements are made accordingly.
4. The next stage is initiation of preparations by the student bodies. There are various tasks which are performed by student bodies like:
 - **Content creation** for the events and their respective brochures;
 - **Preparation of moot problem**, moot rules;
 - **Topics of parliamentary debate and extempore** and their respective rules;
 - **Deciding and styling the prizes, complimentary awards**, etc.

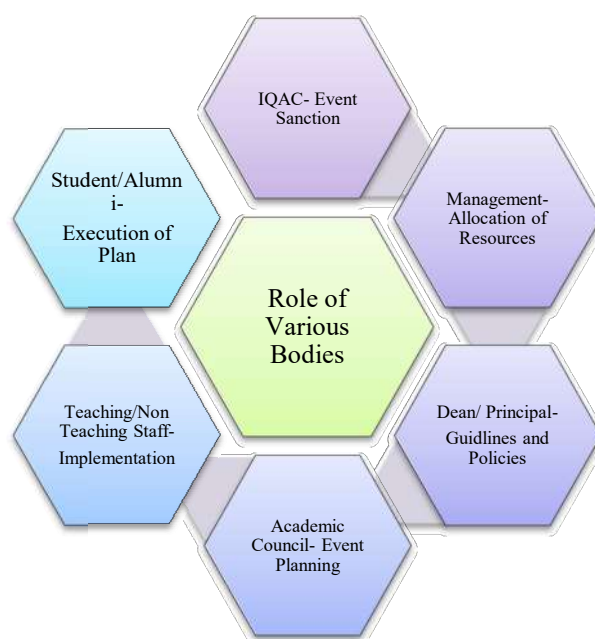
The student bodies submit all this to the Skill Development Cell along with their respective tentative budgets and other requirements for its analysis.

5. The Skill Development Cell after analysing and assessing the demands of the student bodies prepares a final draft of the budget with the guidance and help of various industry experts, teaching and non-teaching staff and it is sent to the Principal of the institute.
6. The **Principal** after scrutinizing the budget forwards it to the **IQAC**, as it is the final authority to approve the budget and sanction funds. The IQAC comprises of all the stake holders of the institute. After discussion on the budget, it is approved (after suggestions and changes if needed) and sent back to the Principal.
7. Further, the Principal in consensus with the Dean of the institute allots and explain the duties to be performed by the faculties.
8. The SDC allots the final duties to the student bodies & student convenor, co-convenors & organizing committees are finalized by all the faculties in staff meeting in consensus with the Principal.

9. **Honourable Judges of Supreme Court and High Courts** are invited to share their thoughts and to motivate the teams for the competitions and for their bright future. Renowned **law stalwarts, social activist, constitutional experts and industrialists** are also invited to judge the competitions & share their knowledge and experience. The Dean authorizes the **Internal Administrative Cell** to make arrangements of hotel accommodation, local transportation, etc., for the judges and other guests.
10. The Internal Administrative Cell is also given the duty to make arrangements for participating teams for their accommodation, meals, local transportation, etc along with student ushers.
11. Furthermore, the Internal Administrative Cell also makes arrangements of a huge dome to capacitate sitting of around 1000 students, flower decorations, mess arrangements, sound systems, campus layouts, etc.
12. Also, the Dean sends the monetary requirements to the Internal Finance and Audit Committee for budget and prize money.
13. *All the faculties and students work for registration, conduction of events, develop contents, judgment sheets, brochures, posters, trophies, certificates, PPTs, moot problems, etc.*
14. The alumni and parent body along with Career Development Cell, help in fetching the Judges for all the events/competitions. The alumni of the institute also help the students in creating the moot problems and various other content.

All the events are covered by the media both print and digital. Reporters from various newspapers like **Dainik Bhaskar, Patrika, Amar Ujala, etc** and from various news channels like **Etv Bharat, News 18, etc., visit the campus and cover the event.**

The management makes arrangements of the Chief Guest and Guest of Honour for the inauguration and valedictory ceremonies of the event. The guests are welcomed by the Governing Body and have lunch and dinner with them. The institute leaves no stone unturned in hospitality of the guests. Even the local authorities are informed beforehand and arrangements are made for the security of guests.



ROLE OF GOVERNING BODY:

The Governing Body as a collective unit form and implements decisions on behalf of its members and the organization for effectively executing and achieving the goals of International Law Fest - Lex Bonanza.

The Governing body is vested with authority to form policies that help steer the organization in a beneficial direction. The Governing body of Indore Institute of Law is solely responsible for outlining budgetary guidelines and allocate the budget in pursuance of the policies and their successful implementation.

CONTRIBUTION OF GOVERNING BODY IN LEX BONANZA

- To recognize and uphold the organization's mission, purpose, priorities and the strategies within the boundaries of the organization's constitution and legal obligations.
- To integrate key stakeholders of organization and meaningful engage them in execution of Lex Bonanza.
- To outline and build policies relating to Lex Bonanza that are pivotal to stakeholders' interest & benefits and to facilitate management in implementation of the same.
- To ensure alignment of resource for Lex Bonanza with the outcomes sought by the organization.
- To consistently self-evaluate with standard of excellence and work towards persistent betterment.
- To formulate & maintain guidelines for risk management in Lex Bonanza to overcome challenges.
- To maintain and perpetuate the plans of Governing Body.

ROLE OF IQAC:

The IQAC clinches and emphasized quality culture as the focal point for consistent and combined efforts with the aim of quality enhancement and progression of educational experience at Indore Institute of Law. The IQAC looks into consistent enhancement of quality and standards in execution of Lex Bonanza and to ensure continued innovation and evolution. The IQAC ensures adherence to the objectives & goals of Lex Bonanza that are mentioned herewith:

- **Collaborative, timely, efficient and progressive performance** of Lex Bonanza along with, academic, administrative and financial engagements.
- Aligning the activities conducted in Lex Bonanza with the vision and mission of nurturing **just, competent, humane & globally sensitised legal professionals**.
- Consistent **inculcation of best practices and innovation** so as to facilitate growth of the event.
- **Efficient & timely work processing of** all the events that come under Lex Bonanza.
- **Uplifting the skills** of the participants through vivid Academic research & programs under the banner of Lex Bonanza.
- Fabricating **affordable & innovative approaches to** make events more illuminating in order to bestow the best to the participants of the event.
- **Best assessment processes** for maintaining quality of the events like legal debates, extempore, moot court competitions etc.

- Ensuring the **best infrastructure to achieve the goals** for the successful completion of the chores relating to The Fest Lex Bonanza and to benefit to the various competitions determining the apt infrastructural milieu.

Thus, IQAC considers all the possible aspects imperative for bringing positive impact of teaching-learning on the students as well as institutions by various academic and skill enhancing activities under the banner of Lex Bonanza.

ROLE OF THE MANAGEMENT:

The Management plays an indispensable role in the events and supervises the comprehensive amelioration of the Institute. It profoundly pays heed on the overall development of the students & participants with special reference to the execution of the co-curricular designs of the institution that aims *to integrate academic learning with practical skill developments in order to train holistic legal professionals.*

The management plays a significant role in successful execution and accomplishing the objectives of Lex Bonanza, they can be briefly outlined as:

- To adhere the orders / instructions given by Education Department / Directorate from time to time regarding legal events.
- To establish Indore Institute of Law as a well-controlled and well managed institution of legal education and promote advanced legal skills with the help of Lex Bonanza.
- To strive to develop IIL as a **connoisseur of legal education** in regards with its infrastructure and quality of education that participants get to experience in Lex Bonanza.
- To bring forth necessary **infrastructural developments** and management required to successfully execute the strategy of Lex Bonanza.
- To create, generate and maintain flow of funds necessary to finance seamless execution of the event.
- To control and manage all the funds of the institution, securities (surety), property and resources, except student funds and to take necessary action for their safe custody, appropriation, repair, maintenance and legal defence.
- The management engages actively in ensuring **hospitality to the guests and judges** for the event, coordinating with local authorities to ensure security and protocol for legal luminaries & dignitaries gracing the event. The management also arranges for visits to holy shrine at Ujjain and ensures best of experience for the resource persons associated with Lex Bonanza.

NON-TEACHING STAFF'S ENGAGEMENT IN LEX BONANZA:

The **Non-Teaching Staff** is considered as one the brawniest pillars of the institution that lift the burden of significant accountabilities in order to benefit the institute by leaps and bounds. The Non-Academic staff of IIL carries out vivid and pivotal chores of **Lex Bonanza**. Non-teaching staff consists of people who are in the college system but do not function as people who impart knowledge directly to the students. They do not have a direct stake in the education of the student but their absence can severely impact the same. Non-teaching staff is an integral part of the system and their everyday functions are what help the institution to function normally and seamlessly without any hiccups or hindrances along the way. If the academic institution is a machinery, the **non-teaching staff is an irreplaceable cog of that machinery** that allows the system to function seamlessly.

Indore Institute of Law includes full-time and part-time administrative, professional, support staff and other personnel paid by or through the institution, excluding academic personnel other than undergraduate and post-graduate students performing paid work for the university.

The Non-Academic Staff members including but not limited to **Cleaning Staff, Transport Staff, Store Keeper, Librarians, Security Staff, Sports staff** who combinedly puts a lot of efforts to make Lex Bonanza more victorious by toiling hard before, during and after the program to ensure a perfectly coordinated and executed experience for all stakeholders. The non-teaching staff is at the forefront of facilitating all the requirements relating to infrastructure, travel, accommodation, meals, coordination of prizes & rewards to be given and ensuring hospitability and optimum experience of all stakeholders in Lex Bonanza.

ROLE OF ACADEMIC COUNCIL & TEACHING STAFF:

The **Academic Council** considers all the matters of academic interest, either on its own initiative or at the instance of the Board of Management or these proposed by the departments / faculty members and to take proper action thereon. Like, it keeps an apt record of events' structure, number of the events and the right diffusion of the academic work:

The Academic Council of Indore Institute of Law pursuant to all other powers and duties vested in it contributes significantly to the successful conduction of Lex Bonanza:

- To frame and exercise general supervision over the **academically oriented co-curricular activities** of the Institute and to proffer directions regarding methods of instruction, evaluation or research or betterments in academic and skill development standards.
- To foster the programs of dictum and acquire reports regarding Lex Bonanza from time to time.
- To ponder over the matters of academic interest either on its own initiative and to take proper action there-on, the academic staff initiates the academic working of Lex Bonanza.
- To make apt arrangements for the successful conduction of academic activities in conformity with the bye-laws. In correlation with the by-laws, the academic staff ensures conformity of rules, **regulations & guideline** of Lex Bonanza.
- To map out the proper standards for the academic co-curricular activities.
- To appoint examiners, moderators, tabulators, and such other personnel for unarbitrary conduction of academic activities.
- To suggest measures for coordination between Student Societies and Clubs.
- To make recommendations to the Board of Management on measures for improving the standard of academic learning & skill development through Lex Bonanza.
- The Teaching Staff is primarily responsible for **creation of intellectual assets required for successful conduction of Lex Bonanza** – the teachers build the concepts of the competitions to be conducted, developing the guidelines, rules & propositions required for the competition. The Teacher's conduct mentoring sessions and pre-training sessions for the participants of the competitions. They also develop all relevant materials like **moot proposition, negotiations terms, meditation**

situation and provide participants with material to prepare themselves. The teachers are also the ones responsible for creation of judgment sheets, marketing criteria and for finalizing the scoring sheets at the conclusion of the competitions.

STUDENTS' INVOLVEMENT & PARTICIPATION:

Legal profession goes far beyond the knowledge of legal textbooks, it is an embodiment of knowledge, skills and strong personalities. Holistic legal education is not only about providing requisite knowledge of the laws but to inculcate interpersonal skills, management skills, leadership, networking skills and executionary skills as well. It is with this pursuit in mind that Indore Institute of Law has an elaborate policies of engaging student committees and volunteers to actively be involved in academic co-curricular activities as well.

The students of Institute contribute significantly to the planning as well as execution of Lex Bonanza, some of the primary responsibilities the students are vested with are listed below:

- Contributing to the conceptualization and framing the co-curricular activities being conducted.
- **Promoting** the event Lex Bonanza in full fervour.
- The student bodies contribute significantly in bringing in **sponsorships, collaborations as well as registration of participants** for successfully conducting the events.
- To make apt **co-ordination with all stakeholders** for perfect execution.

While the Policy Making Bodies, Management, Governing Body and all other stakeholders bring the event to the point of launch, it is the combined efforts of the teachers & students who work as grass root level managers for the successful completion of the event. It is the student bodies convener, co-conveners, management bodies and volunteers who take the day-to-day toil of the 3-day event under tutelage of their faculties and ensures that the entire vision, concept and every arrangement made by the multiple stakeholders is seamlessly executed and every person in attendance of the event has a memorable & learning experience.

ROLE OF ANCILLARY STAKEHOLDERS

The Institute is a success on the cooperative and coordinated efforts of all its stakeholders. In conduction of Lex Bonanza, it is also the **Alumni, Industry Experts & parents-teacher association** who contribute in a supportive manner. The alumni of the Institute who have previously been organizers, conveners, volunteers of Lex Bonanza bring their industry association to the Institute and contributes even to the conceptualization of the competitions,

the alumni significantly contribute in coordination of judges & guests for various competition. The industry experts inclusive of academicians of law, lawyers, law firm experts, judges who engage with **Lex Bonanza** as judges and guests for all the competition, they contribute significantly by devoting their time, efforts and contribution to the adjudication and successful completion of the event. The **Parents-Teacher Association** coordinates for the supportive working of the event, the parents are involved in the event as respected guest and contribute to the Institute with their invaluable feedbacks.

Lex Bonanza is a proud legacy of Indore Institute of Law that grows and flourishes with each passing year only with the uncompromised and invaluable contribution of each and every member of the Institute.

Justice Mr. Ravi Vijaykumar Malimath

His Lordship was born on June 29, 1961 in a small town Joura, District Morena (M.P.). His Lordship graduated in Arts in 1982 and passed LL.B. in 1985 and completed LL.M in 1991. His Lordship was enrolled as an Advocate with the State Bar Council of Madhya Pradesh on November 22, 1985 and practiced in Civil, Criminal, Constitutional, Service and Tax matters. His Lordship was the elected member of the M.P. State Bar Council. His Lordship was appointed as Additional Judge of the High Court of Madhya Pradesh on November 25, 2005 and on November 25, 2008, appointed as permanent Judge of the Hon'ble Court. His Lordship was a part of various committees, pertaining to betterment of administration of High court of Madhya Pradesh and continued his good offices till October 06, 2019.

His Lordship was transferred as Chief Justice of Andhra Pradesh High Court and assumed office on October 07, 2019. His Lordship was the First Chief Justice of the newly established Andhra Pradesh High Court.

His Lordship was transferred as the Chief Justice of the High Court of Sikkim on January 06, 2021.

His Lordship has taken oath as a Judge of the Supreme Court of India on August 31, 2021.

About J.K Maheshwari

Justice Jitendra Kumar Maheshwari enrolled as an advocate with the State Bar Council of Madhya Pradesh in 1985. He graduated in Arts in 1982 and passed LL.B in 1985 and completed LL.M in 1991. He practiced as an advocate for 20 years and practiced in civil, criminal, constitutional, service and tax matters. He was a member of the Madhya Pradesh state Bar Council from 2002 and was the Chairman of the Disciplinary Committee of the Gwalior Bench.

In 2005, he was appointed as the Additional Judge of the High Court of Madhya Pradesh. In 2008, Maheshwari J was made a permanent judge. He was the first Chief Justice (CJ) of the Andhra Pradesh High Court in 2019. He was transferred to the Sikkim High Court as CJ in January 2021. He has taken oath as a judge of the supreme court of India on August 31, 2021.

MOOT PROPOSITION

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. This is the final stage of an appeal under Section 37 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The Presiding Judge has declared that the pleadings are complete, and the parties are now to present their final arguments for final disposal of the case at motion stage itself.
2. The case is entirely fictional. Teams should confine themselves to the facts supplied. Neither the Appellant nor the Respondent may introduce new facts. The Moot Problem includes all the facts supported by the evidence that has been presented before the Court. Teams may nonetheless draw reasonable inferences from the facts produced. They may also question the credibility or weight of the Statute.
3. Teams should not hand anything to judges unless asked to by a Judge.
4. The problem is not intended to raise questions of procedure before the Court. Procedural questions should be ignored.
5. The problem is not intended to raise questions relating to the power of SPL to get into a sub contract. Although issues of admissibility are not normally dealt with at such later stages in Arbitration, counsels may in this instance address issues regarding the admissibility of the case if relevant.

The Court may apply principles and the rules of law as interpreted in previous decisions of Indian Courts.

BACKGROUND:

Isepor is a union of Island States that recently declared their independence from a long termed occupancy by Mordor, a close neighbor of India. Mordor had a Federal System of Governance and Isepor was the hub for its seafood industry and shared 65% of total sea based resource exports. While under the occupation, Mercantile Laws of Mordor enabled various exporters with discounted logistics and hence many industries grew exponentially over the past decade. The high rate of profits and alluring geographical location for trade attracted many corporates to setup their establishments in Isepor.

SPL is a company registered under The Companies Act, 2001 of Mordor, indulging in various infrastructure development projects. While Isepor was still under administrative control of Mordor, SPL was awarded the tender for restructuring of the entire Arabian Coast Highway connecting Kofland to Edowood by the Federal Government of Isepor. The Conditions of Contract contained the following Settlement of Dispute Clause:

"12. SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

- 12.1 All disputes and differences of any kind whatsoever arising out of or in connection with the contract, whether during the progress of the work or after its completion and whether before or after the determination of the contract, shall be referred by the Claimant to the "Chief Engineer" through "Notice of Dispute". The parties shall try to achieve an amicable solution to the dispute.
- 12.2 In the event of any dispute or difference between the parties hereto as to the construction or operation of this contract, or the respective rights and liabilities of the parties on any matter in question, shall demand in writing by means of Notice of Arbitration.
- 12.3 The arbitration proceedings pertaining to the dispute or differences shall be conducted before "Minister of Roadways, Government of Isepor" and administered under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

- 12.4 The parties may waive off the applicability of Sub-Section 12(5) of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, if they agree for such waiver in writing, after dispute having arisen between them, in the format given under Annexure XV of these conditions.
- 12.5 The number of arbitrators shall be one, nominated/appointed in concurrence with clause 12.3 of this agreement.
- 12.6 The language of arbitration proceedings shall be English.
- 12.7 The Arbitration proceedings shall be assumed to have commenced from the day, Notice of Arbitration is received by the Defendant.
- 12.8 Seat of Arbitration: The Seat of Arbitration would be within the geographical limits of the Isepor where the cause of action arose with the written consent of both the parties.
- 12.9 Obligation During Pendency of Arbitration: Work under the contract shall, unless otherwise directed by the Supervising Engineer, continue during the arbitration proceedings, and no payment due or payable by either parties shall be withheld on account of such proceedings, provided, however, it shall be open for Arbitral Tribunal to consider and decide whether or not such work should continue during arbitration proceedings.”

Moonlit is a firm registered under The Companies Act, 1956 specialising in electrification work. SPL's field of expertise was limited to 'Civil Work' therefore, for the purpose of electrification of the Highway, SPL decided to delegate the partial work to Moonlit.

Before the sub-contract was signed and the work order issued in favour of Moonlit, the revolt broke out in Isepor and the existing Mordor Government fell rendering Isepor free from occupation. The newly formed Government of Isepor decided to gradually reform its legal structure highly influenced by the one existing in India. The foreign policies of Isepor also granted India the status of most favoured nation. Thereafter, SPL and Moonlit entered into a Works' Contract (hereinafter referred as the "**Contract**") aimed towards completion of

electrification work on the Highway in three phases spanning over a period of 3 years. The Settlement of Disputes Clause was reiterated in the Contract as present in the main contract.

Over the period of next year Moonlit finished the Phase-I of Contract and the amount for the same was due to be paid to Moonlit. SPL could not fulfil the promise of partial payment in favour of Moonlit at the time, stating that the payment was awaited from the Government of Isepor. After receiving reasonable assurances of delayed payment, Moonlit continued the work as per the conditions of contract without any objections. Over the period of next six months Moonlit could not carry out the work order pertaining to Phase-II due to insufficiency of funds and could not continue further developing the Highway.

Moonlit vide its communication conveyed the difficulties faced by the firm to SPL in response to which SPL paid the dues partially, enough for Moonlit to carry its further obligations towards the contract. Moonlit with dwindling trust refused to commence the work unless the entire payment for Phase-I was made. SPL irate of delay, imposed a penalty on Moonlit for delayed progress of Phase-II. Thereafter, Moonlit served the Notice to Arbitration seeking the following relief:

“9. It is most respectfully prayed that –

- a. Payment of arrears be made in full with 12% interest.*
- b. Penalties levied by SPL be revoked being unlawful and arbitrary.”*

SPL in reply to the Notice of Arbitration submitted that penalty for delayed work progress is well within the provisions of the Contract and interest sought on the payment of arrears is not payable, since Moonlit had not objected to the affirmed request of delayed payment. Thereafter, the Arbitral Tribunal was setup and proceedings initiated on behest of the claimant - Moonlit. Moonlit filed the Statement of Claims and filed an application under Section 17 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 during the pendency of Arbitral proceedings, praying for the following interim relief:

“Execution of the Contract be stayed and Moonlit be protected from illegal termination of Contract till the pendency of arbitral proceedings.”

Moonlit prayed for the exact same relief alongwith other relief(s) that the Tribunal might deem fit and proper under the facts and circumstances of the case on grounds that (i) the penalty

imposed on Moonlit is arbitrary and exhibits colorable exercise of authority (ii) payment of arrears is not only the right of Moonlit but essential to completion of the Contract and (iii) the delay caused in completion of Phase-II is not on accord of Moonlit.

SPL filed the Statement of Defence and raised the same objections as in the Reply to Notice to Arbitration. The Arbitration Tribunal while deciding the Application for Interim Relief did not find substance in the Claim and rejected the application on grounds raised by the defendant stating that the interim relief sought by Moonlit adversely affects third party interests. Further the Tribunal held that cessation of work is in violation of the terms of contract and ruled in favour of SPL while simultaneously directing Moonlit to pay the penalties and resume work pertaining to Contract.

Aggrieved by the award Moonlit moved an application under Section 34 for setting aside the Award raising the grounds of challenging the arbitrator as he is a direct party to the main contract. Among other objections raised was the inability of Moonlit to operate under the terms of contract because the delayed payment affected the procurement of essential raw materials to continue the operation of the Contract. Further Moonlit averred that the Award infringes its fundamental rights enshrined in the Constitution of Isepor. In the meanwhile, SPL moved ^{an} application for enforcement of the Award wherein the court satisfied from the prospects of SPL successfully defending the appeal ordered Moonlit to deposit security amount with the Legal Services Authority of Isepor and stayed the enforcement proceedings. SPL in response to the objections of Moonlit stated that the application under Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 was not maintainable under the Jurisdiction of Isepor since the main contract is governed by the Arbitration Laws of Mordor and hence the court cannot entertain a petition within the territorial jurisdiction of Isepor. Further the Arbitrator correctly rendered the Award in favour of SPL since the dispute arose out of non fulfilment of contractual obligations by Moonlit.

The court while setting aside the award of Arbitrator held that the award stands in violation of the public policy of Isepor and the dispute is appropriately covered under the its jurisdiction as the agreement between SPL and Moonlit is distinct from the Main Contract. The court further held that primary violation of obligations was on accord of SPL when the payment was not made to Moonlit. The court also upheld the contentions raised by Moonlit pertaining to the competence

of Arbitrator for the reasons of him being a vicariously interested party in the completion of Main contract.

Based on the legal opinion received from its advocates, SPL has moved to appeal before Hon'ble High Court of Edwood. The High Court on perusal of facts had issued notices to Moonlit and the matter is listed for final disposal at motion stage.

PREPARATION OF THE BRIEF:

In preparing the brief, the counsels for both Appellant and Respondent are expected to establish the following points: -

The law that is applicable to the present case;

The elements of dispute for each of the two instances that have to be established by the Respondent for the purpose of dismissal of appeal;

Applicable law and policy and supporting authorities. Written and oral arguments on behalf of the Appellant and Respondent are limited to the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 unless the Act allows for derivatives from different Statutes.

Questions relating to authority over entering a sub-contract shall not be raised unless they are linked to the substance or the merits of the case.

The laws of Isepor are *pari materia* with the laws of India.
