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## **INITIATIVES**

*Policy on Environmental & Energy Usage* of the College shall follow a three-pronged approach based on the principle of **sustainable development**.

### **1. Resource Maintenance**

- Protect existing flora, especially old trees within the campus.
- Careful use of infrastructure by both students and staff to prevent unnecessary repairs and replacements.

- Natural Sedimentation
- Landscaping of the college campus to increase green cover.

- Students and staff are encouraged to donate clothes, books, etc rather than throwing them in the trash, which eventually ends in the landfill.
- Best to waste management through solid, liquid and waste management.

### • 3. Resource Wastage Minimization

- Ban on use of single-use plastics.
- Private automobiles are not allowed which makes the campus green and clean.
- Tiles are properly laid down in the entire campus to absorb water slowly and with ease.
- Staff and students shall be mindful while using water and electricity
- Use of stairs rather than lifts whenever possible
- Staff and students shall switch off fans, bulbs, air-conditions etc. when leaving the room.
- Recycling of waste paper that is generated in the campus
- Regular collection of e-waste to be carried out in College.
- Regular maintenance of taps to water pipes to prevent waste
- Popularise use of menstrual cups among students and staff.
- The College shall ensure availability of potable water to prevent use bottled water.
- Ensure proper segregation of waste by providing different-coloured waste bins
- Attendance shall be taken online to prevent paper wastage
- Students to be encouraged to submit assignments online.

- Solar Energy is tapped through installed solar plates in the college.
- Sensor Based Energy Conservation reduces energy wastages.
- Biogas Plant generate electricity other than removing wastages.
- LED saves energy to a great extent.

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## Restricted Entry of Automobiles

- Institute has designated **Vehicle Parking Areas** for staff and students, college buses and vehicles parking. Apart from parking area rest of the campus is strictly a **No Vehicle Zone**. Only bicycles are allowed inside the campus.
- The Institute encourages the staff and students to use the institute conveyance instead of their vehicles for safety, security, fuel conservation and to reduce environmental pollution.
- Visitors' vehicles are **not allowed inside the campus** they have to park their vehicles in the area designated outside the campus. Institute devised a system of **Gatepass for visitor's**, allotted at the main entrance to enter in the campus. They have to park their vehicle outside the campus and walk thereafter in the campus. **Without pass visitors entry is strictly prohibited.**
- Vehicles are Periodically Checked for pollution.

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## CIRCULAR

All the staff and students are hereby informed that as part of the **Go Green Initiative**, only the restricted entry of automobiles inside the campus is permitted. All the visitors are supposed to park their vehicles in the designated area outside the campus and students and staff are instructed to park their vehicles in the designated parking area in the campus only. Any student, staff or outsiders parking their vehicles outside the designated area will face disciplinary action.

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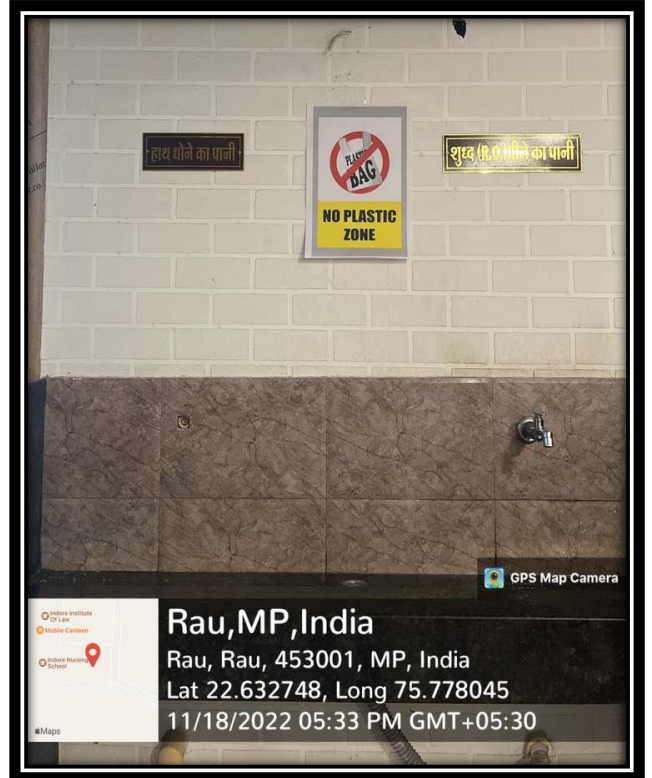

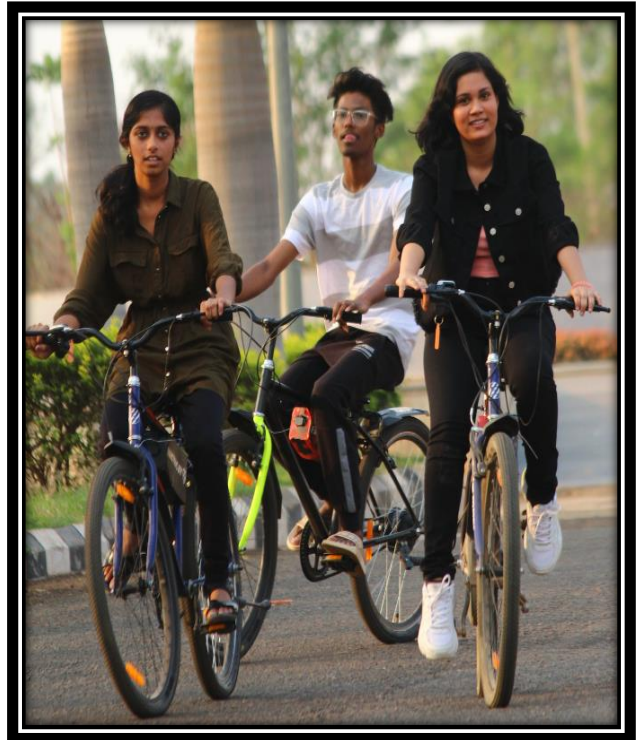

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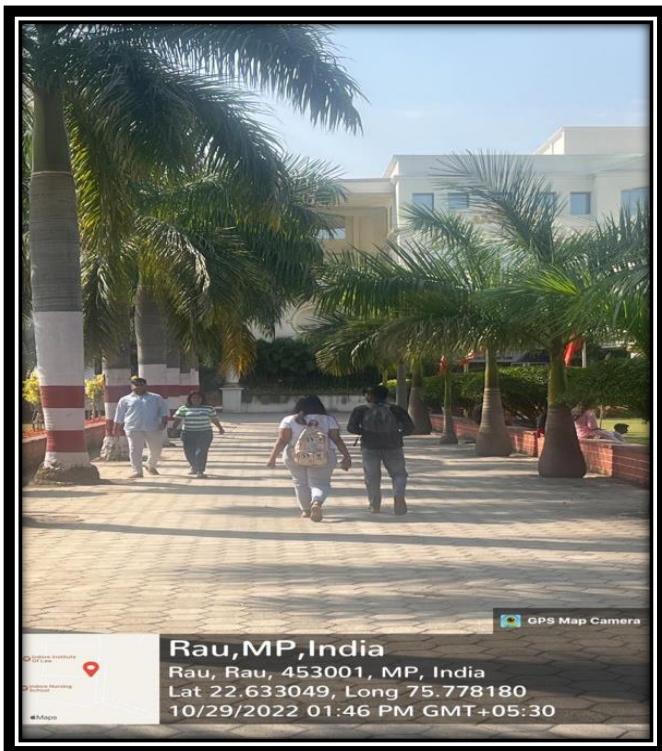
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## Pedestrian-Friendly pathways

- IIL has designated **Pedestrian-Friendly pathways** which are strictly **No Vehicle Zone**.
- Institute ensures that vehicles are permitted only within the parking area of the campus this enhances walkway path and pedestrian friendly roads.
- Being a residential campus with around 600 students' campus has 4 grounds and Pedestrian-Friendly Pathways wherein students take part in various sports activities, Jogging, walking, Meditation and Yoga activities under guidance of Sports officer Mr. Yogendra Deshmukh who stays in campus till 8 p.m. Thus, **No vehicle Zone is utilised too the fullest** by the students.

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## Ban on the use of Plastics

- Go Green club, IIL is making an untiring effort to "**Reduce Plastic Pollution**" by minimizing plastic footprints by way of **3Rs** i.e. **Refuse, Reduce and Reuse**.
- In view of the Government of India's resolution to **ban all single use plastics** due to the hazardous impact of plastic use and pollution, the **college administration strictly bans** the use of single use plastics in its premise to make it a '**Plastic Free Campus**'.
- Usage of plastic bags is strictly prohibited in the campus, which has been declared as a '**No Plastic Zone**'. Institute is promoting **use of jute bags** instead of plastic bags.
- IIL **Encourage** the use of durable, foldable and cheap reusable bags that may be carried around in a car, pocket or purse. Institute **discourage** plastic bottles and instead use glass, steel or clay bottles in office.
- Institute Canteen has become **completely plastic free** by shifting to **Paper and Steel glasses** and other utensils. We ensure minimal use of plastic products to promote **Sustainable Development**.
- Apart from Academic excellence IIL is known for its events. IIL invites Guests for its events who are presented with a memento. IIL has **Practice of giving Goody bags and penholder made up of Wood as memento** and discarded plastic materials completely.
- **IIL as a practice** incorporate the use of Dispenser, cooler and steel glasses for drinking water for daily use. During events Guests and visitors are served water in glasses rather than in single use plastic bottles. Plastics bottles are discouraged in the campus for drinking purposes.

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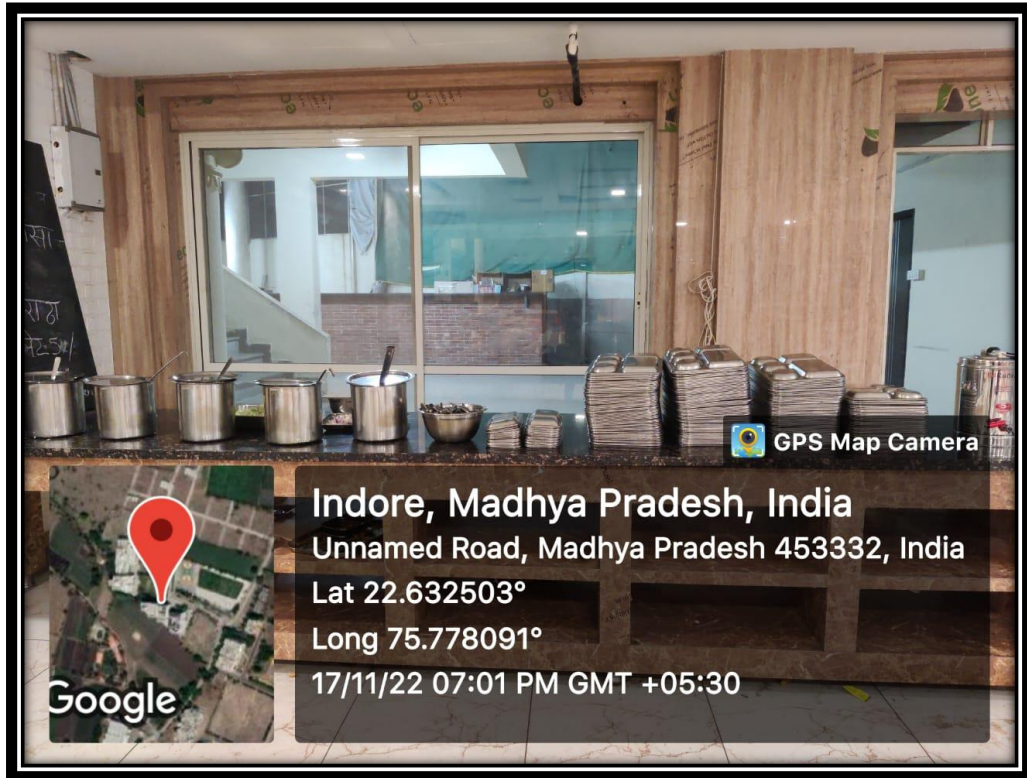

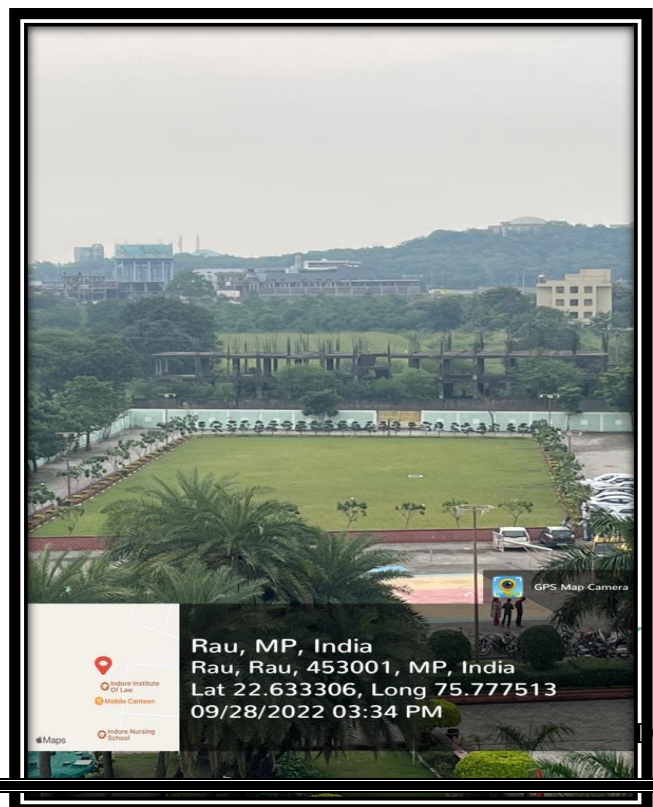
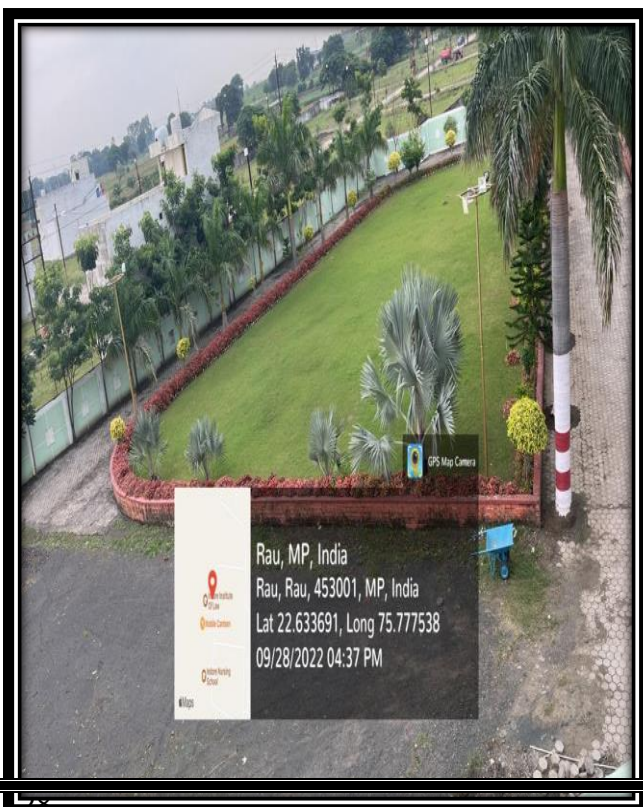
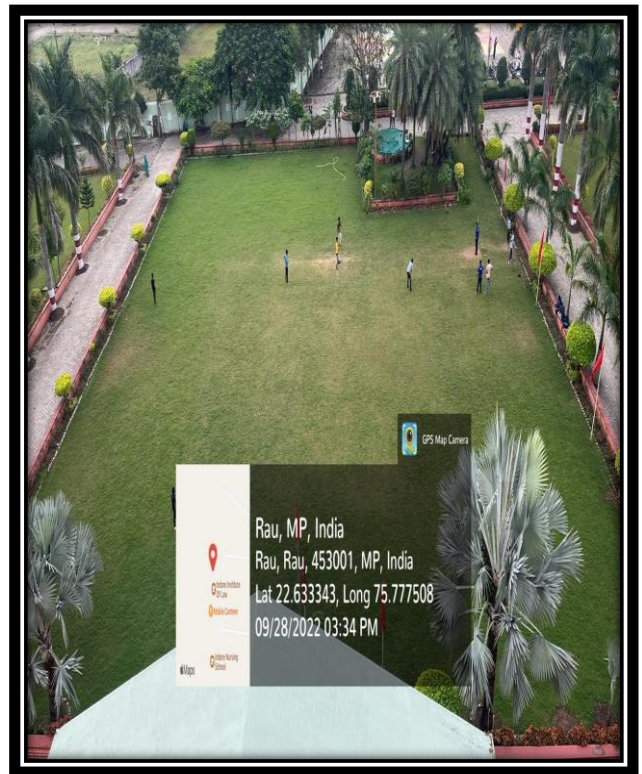
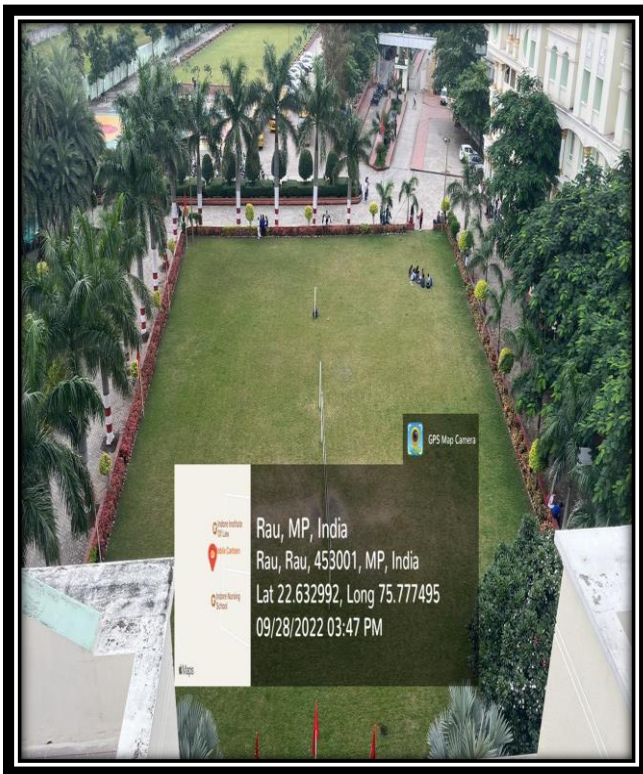
- **IIL** has beautiful campus covered with variety of Plants and Trees. Approximately 60% area of the campus is covered with green landscape which includes four gardens and around **3000 plants and trees**. Thus IIL has varied range of **Bio-diversity** in terms of Flora.
- Green cover at IIL has variety of flora wherein wide ranging variety of plants and trees including **Indigenous and Medicinal plants** are planted and nurtured.
- The **‘Go Green Club’** of IIL spearheads numerous activities aimed at increasing green cover through plantation drives **within and outside the campus**.
- Luscious green campus of IIL is the result of earnest efforts taken by staff, teachers, students and management for maintaining it; campus has all round green cover with different kinds of plants and trees consciously conserved. All **Trees and plants** including the trees at Main Entrance gate in the **campus are QR coded**.
- Trees and plants are the **‘environmental lungs’** of the campus providing clean Air to breath and a healthy environment to live. NSS unit and Students Representative bodies of IIL **adopts trees and plants** and take care of them on regular basis.
- Institute has appointed Gardeners who took care of campus greenery and bio-diversity by giving water and manure as per requirements. Few gardens in the Campus are dedicated for **seasonal flowers** which increases the **beauty as well as bio-diversity** of the campus.
- Students and staff of the Institute observe a **manual day** in every **15 days** as a part of **clean and green campus drive**. On this day for 2 hours students take care of trees and plants adopted by them by giving them water, manure and cutting where required along with the

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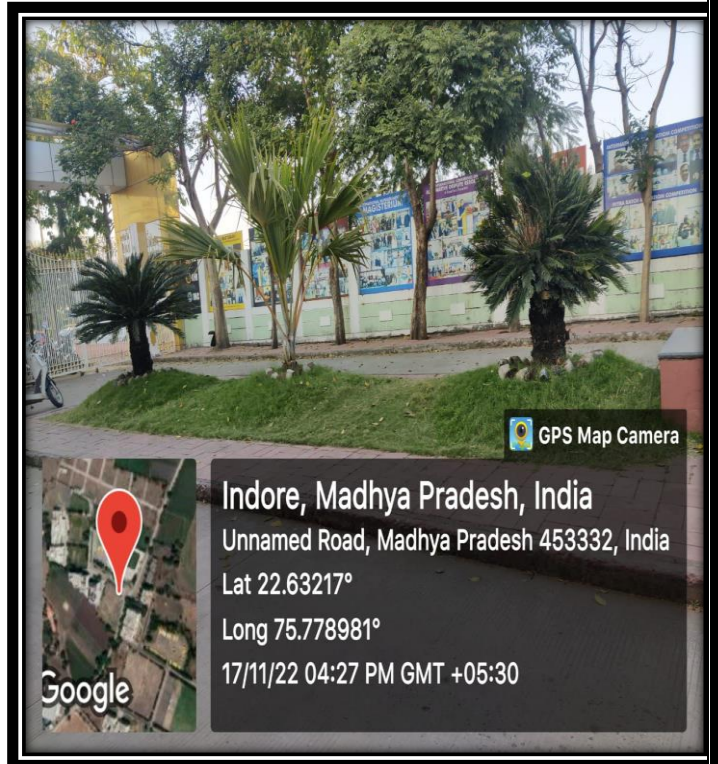
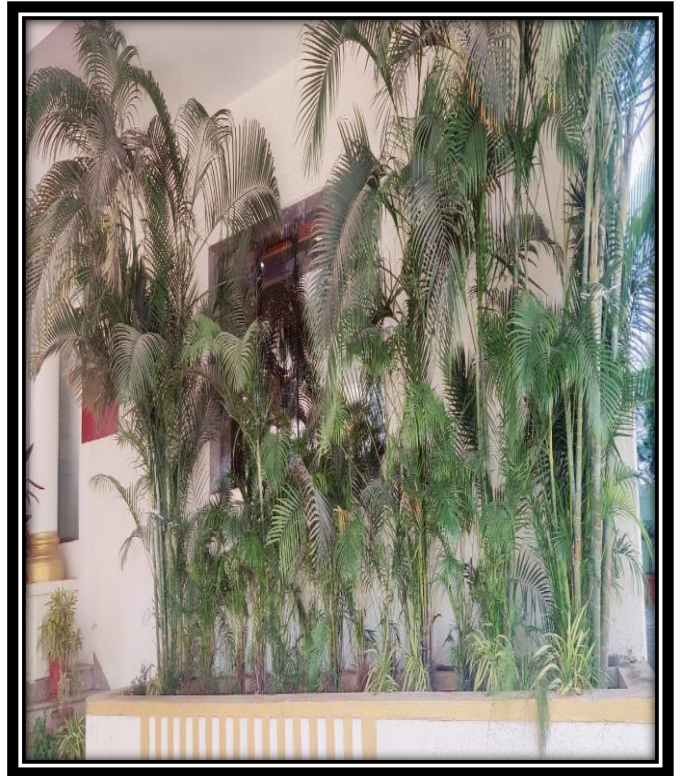

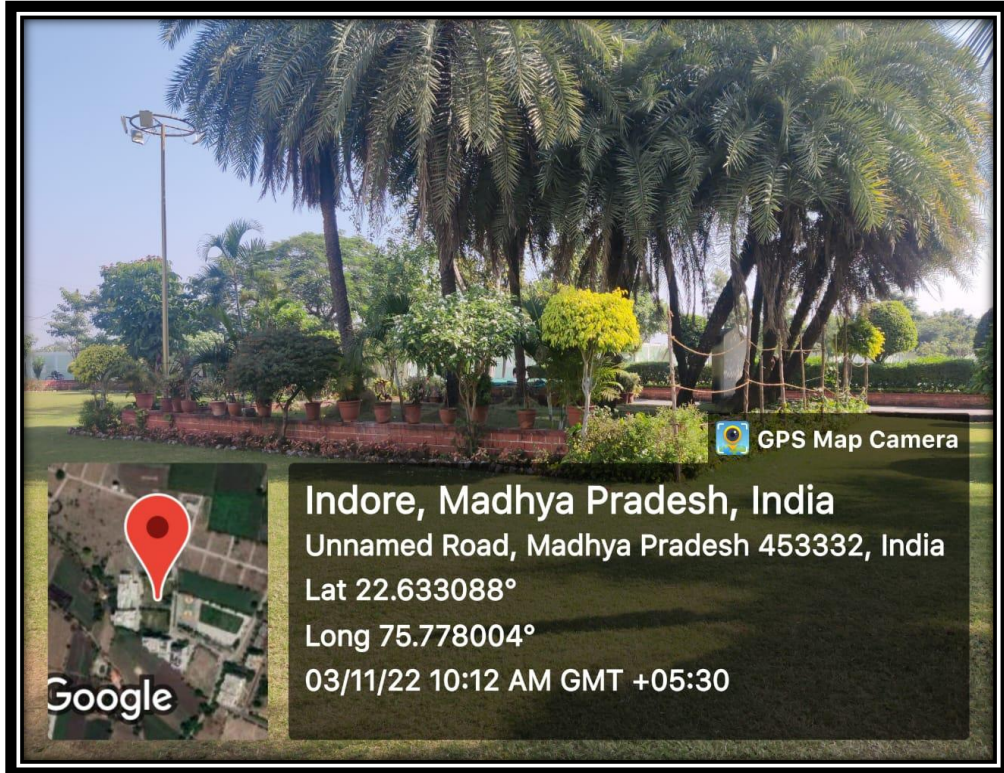

वर्ष 1996 से पर्यावरण संरक्षण अनुसंधान एवं विकास केन्द्र एक राष्ट्रीय स्तर पर कार्य कर रहा है। शहर व प्रदेश में पर्यावरण हितकारी कार्यों विशेषतः पर्यावरण स्वच्छता, शैक्षणिक विकास, पर्यावरण से संबंधित विषयों में शोध, शौर ऊर्जा, पर्यावरण विधि, जल ससाधन, नगरीय विकास, जैविक खेती, प्रदूषण रोकथाम आदि विषयों के कार्य समूह बनाये गये हैं। समय-समय पर चर्चा, कार्यशाला, व्याख्यान, परिचर्चा आदि के माध्यम से जन जागरण कार्य किये जाते हैं।

पर्यावरण संरक्षण में युवाओं की भागीदारी के लिये शैक्षणिक संस्थानों में संस्था के 'बेष्टर' खोले जाते हैं। पर्यावरण शिक्षा के विकास हेतु पर्यावरण बोध के नाम से एक पुरस्तक का भी प्रकाशन किया गया है। यह छात्रों व शिक्षकों के लिये विशेष उपयोगी है। संस्था 1996 से पर्यावरण संबंधित विषयों पर प्रतिमाह पर्यावरण विकास पत्रिका का प्रकाशन सतत किया जा रहा है। संस्था पर्यावरण संरक्षण संबंधित शोध कार्य में अपने अनुभवी विशेषज्ञों की मदद से सहायता करती है।

जलवायु परिवर्तन के लिये राकफेलर फाउंडेशन के साथ जलसंरक्षण शोध का महत्वपूर्ण कार्य किया है। प्रतिवर्ष स्वच्छ पर्यावरण, स्वच्छ इन्दौर, जल पुनर्गणन, जैविक खेती, ऊर्जा संरक्षण, सोलर ऊर्जा, यातायात प्रबंधन आदि विषयों पर भी व्याख्यान, सेमिनार, वर्कशॉप आदि आयोजित किये जाते हैं। प्रतिवर्ष पर्यावरण संरक्षण संबंधित विषयों पर व्याख्यानमाला भी आयोजित होती है। तीन दिवसीय इस व्याख्यान माला में शहर के जागरूक श्रोताओं के साथ विश्वविद्यालय एवं महाविद्यालय के शिक्षक एवं विद्यार्थी भाग लेते हैं। भाग लेने वाले विद्यार्थियों को संस्था द्वारा प्रमाण-पत्र भी दिया जाता है।

पर्यावरण से संबंधित विषयों के लिये संस्था विभिन्न महाविद्यालयों में भी निःशुल्क व्याख्यान आयोजित करती है। इसमें देश के ख्याती प्राप्त विद्वान विषय विशेषज्ञ अपना उद्बोधन देते हैं। आपकी सुविधानुसार तिथि पर एक पर्यावरण विषय भी प्रस्तावित है। जिसके पुरस्कार सीईपीआरडी द्वारा दिये जायेंगे।

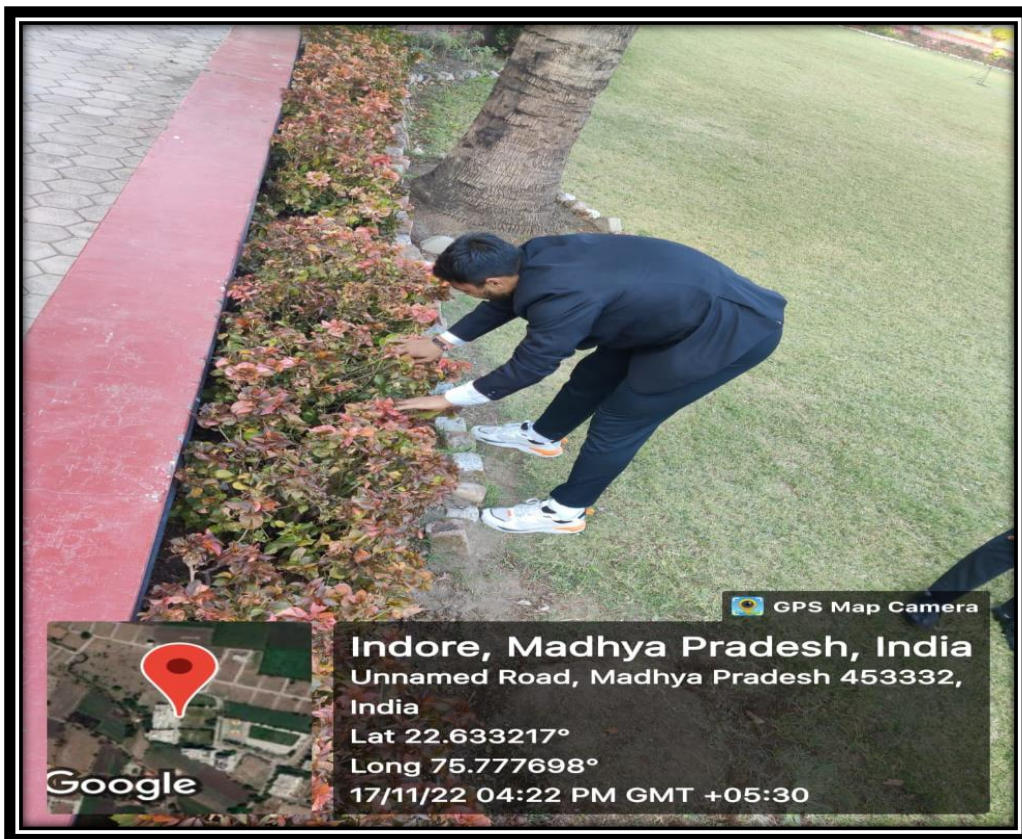
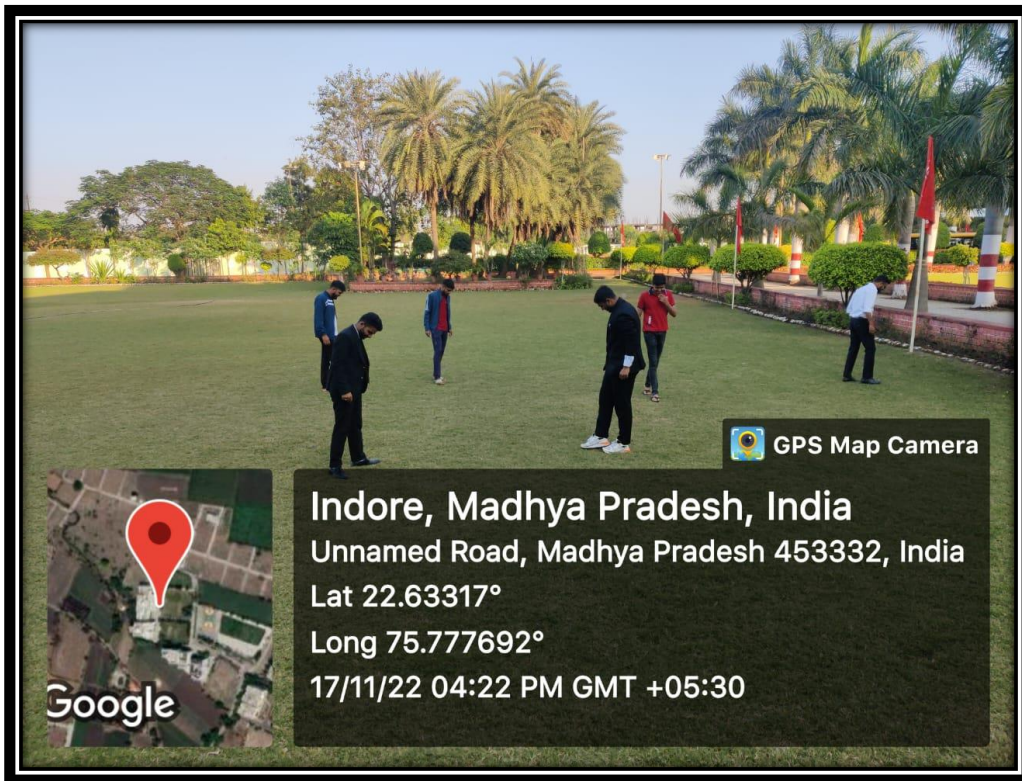

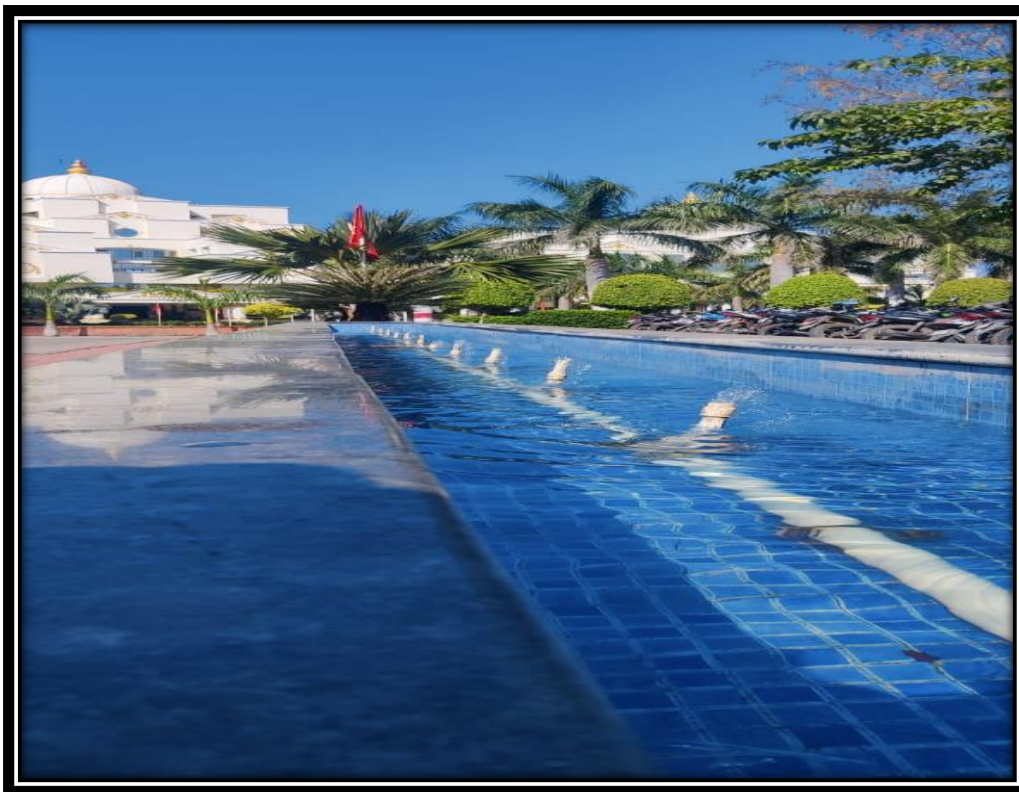
